WHAT IS OPERATION ROUND UP?

Operation Round Up supports local organizations by collecting money from members who sign up to have their electric bill rounded up to the next dollar.



HOW MUCH IS COLLECTED?

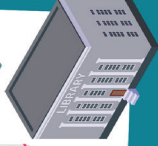
The average account contributes \$6 a year. The most a member could contribute is \$11.88 (99¢ a month). In 2021, 1,955 members contributed a total of \$13,050.
